

#### ::: Foreword

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For all participants of the Glemseck 101 - 1/8 Mile 2024

The 1/8 Mile, half the distance of a 1/4 Mile, is a real rider's distance. It's not just the performance of the motorcycle that counts. As often proven at the Glemseck 101, even a less powerful motorcycle can win against a stronger opponent over this distance: saving the lead from the start over the approx. 201 meters crossing the finish line!

# The 1/8 Mile according to Glemseck 101 rules is analog: »Old School« 1/8 Mile Racing


There are no red-green-light at the start. No light barrier at the finish line. Participants will be sent into the 1/8 Mile via a »Flag Girl« with the »Chequered Flag« and the winner will be confirmed via a »Human Target Eye» with the »Red Flag».

Even though motorbikes are becoming more and more complex, both technically and creatively: this purely »analogue» implementation, the renunciation of any electronic technical aids and of timekeeping, makes the 1/8 Mile of the Glemseck 10 something special. Adrenalin, joy and great pictures – especially at the start – for the participants, photographers as well as the audience.

With this type of organizing the 1/8 Mile – the Glemseck 101 has been successful since 2009 and is a role model for other events.

# ::: YOU DON'T REGISTER FOR THE GLEMSECK 101 1/8 MILE, YOU APPLY

Basically: You do not register for one of the listed 1/8 Mile sprints, **you apply!** With the respective organizer / contact person of the sprint. You will only be on the 101 starting line on the 101 weekend once you have been confirmed.

# ::: For your application open and still closed 1/8 Mile Sprints 2024

Some of the listed 1/8 Mile sprints are currently open for your 2024 application. Others will be opened for application in the coming weeks. See the following pages with the respective regulations.

# **Recommendation:**

# ::: APPLICATIONS FOR ALREADY OPEN 1/8 MILE SPRINTS

Send your application by email to the relevant contact person. Their contact details / email are listed for each sprint. **Please do not write novels!** Send a **short description** (what would fit on an A4 sheet!) and **1 - 3 current pictures** of your motorcycle. (In the size of 1 to 2 MB per picture. This is sufficient in terms of quality.

And take a photo of your motorcycle against a neutral background! You apply with your motorcycle. Your motorcycle is the star! Nothing and no one else.



# ::: Starting Fee per participant: 50,- Euro

The Glemseck 101 - 1/8 Mile sprints are started with insurance coverage and under the highest safety standard. The »1/8 Mile« will be inspected by the DMSB\* and to ensure that everything runs smoothly, a race inspector will also be on site.

# A valid 1/8 Mile DMSB license for the 101 weekend will be issued by the Race Control Team of the 101 AFTER successful application and AFTER payment of the entry fee of 50 euros for each participant.

You will receive the payment modalities for this DMSB license (PayPal / bank details) with the confirmation of participation.

In case of cancellation AFTER a confirmation as well as in case of cancellation during the event, there will be no refund of the starting fee.


# ::: GLEMSECK 101 IS A LONG WEEKEND!

Only apply if you can be there for the entire Glemseck 101 weekend, from Friday to Sunday! Your planned arrival is on 101 Friday morning to afternoon at the latest.

- Due to the high number of visitors, we have always had to close the entrance to the 101 area on 101 Saturday mornings in recent years. This also applies to the 101 paddock.
- The 101 Race Office already opens for registration on 101 Friday evening: DMSB paperwork and »Technical acceptance« - and it's a "Big Show" for our audience as well as for you. Right in the heart of the 101.
- We have two long and awesome 101 nights. As a participant, you really shouldn't miss these two long party nights.

# ::: UNIQUE HIGH PERFORMANCE CUSTOM MOTORCYCLES

The Sprint International has a tradition of over 12 years on our 1/8 Mile. While in the first two years the most powerful »cafe racers« competed against each other, today it is the 101 Sprint, in which customizers, tuners, builders, brands, designers and characters from the entire motorcycle scene come together and compete against with their unique motorcycles at Glemseck 101. Often enough, these are motorcycles that visitors at trade fairs can only admire behind barriers or in pictures on well-known customizer online portals.

#### At our 101 these motorcycles roar and race!

#### ::: SHOWROOM VS 1/8 MILE

Our 1/8 Mile gets a lot of attention in the national and international press as well as all over social media. The pictures and videos of the participating motorcycles from »The Draw« and then from the sprint itself, lurking at the starting line for the flag to fall and then heading towards the braking zone at full throttle in front of the unique scenery of the Glemseck 101 grandstand with 1200 spectators – go around the world after the event. These are pictures that »roar« louder than a showroom shooting ever could.



#### ::: 101 Sprint International 2024 - Technical requirements

In this 101 Sprint, it is neither about the number of cylinders, the cubic capacity nor the year of manufacture. Every customizing style is allowed. It's about the uniqueness of the motorcycle in technology and design.

Steven Flier values the »WOW« effect for the 101 spectator looking at the motorcycle in resting position as in the sprint on the 1/8 Mile. In short: It's about beasts on two wheels.

• NO dragster construction

(For this construction type there is the Rocket Race Club Est. 101, see page 12)

- NO overlong swing arms
- NO flat drag strip tires but motorcycle tires! NO EXCEPTION!
- Unique character: NO Motorcycles for or from the race track

Steven's personal default:

»In Sprint International, the best and most unique custom motorcycles compete against each other, which could also handle an alpine pass.«

# ::: REQUIRED PERFORMANCE DENSITY IN THIS SPRINT

Between 140 and 300 hp. Anyone applying for this sprint needs performance at the rear wheel! But the years 2022 and 2023 have also proven: Outstanding rear wheel performance is not everything in this sprint, as in the other 1/8 Mile sprints! An ,underdog' motorcycle with the right one as rider can win:

• Winner 2022: Stefan Bronold sen. on his Moto Guzzi ,Cento Anni' - 164 PS

• Winner 2023: Nick Eiberger on his Triumph Thruxton RS ,Cosmic Blaze' - 140 PS



The MO Cafe Racer Sprint offers the chance for start-ups of the custom scene as well as reckless amateurs to present their classic as well as modern Cafe Racer interpretations on the legendary 1/8 Mile of the Glemseck. Since 2019 also based on smaller, modern single-cylinder and two-cylinder engines.

#### ::: RULES OF THE STYLE

The MO-Cafe Racer-Sprint reflects our own Glemseck 101 history. Cafe Racers were the first motorcycles on our 1/8 Mile setting the starting line for all sprints today. That's why we set a HIGH VALUE on the fact that the motorcycles participating in this sprint are constructions and interpretations in a classic and modern Cafe Racer style. In short: Your motorcycle with which you want to apply – and regardless of the type of engine listed below – should LOOK like a Cafe Racer!

#### **::: TECHNISCHES REGLEMENT**

- No restrictions in the year of construction
- Single-cylinder: No cubic capacity restriction, water-cooled engines allowed
- Two-cylinder up to 750 cc: water-cooled engines allowed
- Two-cylinder over 750 cc: NO water-cooled engines
- Three-cylinder: Max. 1000 cc, NO water-cooled engines
- Four-cylinder: Max. 750 cc, NO water-cooled engines
- The motorcycle must be street legal


#### **:::** RULES OF THE STYLE


The emphasis in this sprint is on classic »sport motorcycles«. Close to serial, but also nice to see rebuilt and sport-customised. From the Yamaha RD 250, the Suzuki GT750 called »Kettle« or »Water buffalo«, the wide six-cylinder Honda CBX, the Guzzi Le Mans up Katana and Z900. We are also happy to see motorcycles of the former noble-tuners like Egli, Bimota, Martin, Rickman and Co. in the starting grid.

#### **::: TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

- Engine and chassis up to 1985
- Two-stroke and four-stroke
- No restrictions on the number of cylinders and in cubic capacity
- The motorcycle must be street legal

All modifications and tuning conversions in the style of these earlier times are allowed. As a pictorial example: A Suzuki GS 1000 S with »Katana« swing arm and »Koni«-shocks works. A »Katana« conversion with GSX-R suspension does not work.



Here you compete with 2-cylinder engines. Water or air-cooled. With supercharging (NOS, turbo, compressor) and without cubic capacity limit.

# Rolf Reick about his E-Motorcycle Sprint:

"As a result of the success of my converted 'BMW C evolution Scooter', which take part in StarrWars 2019, called ,E-Lisabad', the desire for my own E-Sprint arose. This sprint was then launched by KRAUTMOTORS at Glemseck 101 in 2022: The first ,E-Custom Bike 1/8 Mile Sprint' in Europe! With E-Dragster against scooters, Harley Lifewire against Energica from Italy."

#### **::: TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

The rules were originally tailored to all-electric ,custom bikes<sup>4</sup>. Conversions or self-builds with electric drive. No original manufacturer aka series motorcycles.

For 2024, these rules have been extended to all motorcycles and scooters, including series(!), with new drive concepts! E-drive, hybrid, hydrogen or ,warp';) - we will let you surprise us. University projects are also very welcome. A fair class division will then take place directly on site at the 101. And of course, front and rear brakes are mandatory.

The basic rules for this 1/8 Mile sprint is:

As always, exceptions are possible in consultation with Rolf Reick. These are exceptional vehicles – and therefore exceptional rules apply!


# ::: ROCKT' ROLLER IN COMPANY OF ROCKET RACE CLUB EST. 101

After their first and truly spectacular 1/8 Mile appearance in 2023, this class is of course again set by Team 101 at the Glemseck 101 - 2024!

The "Rock't Roller" class is a racing category where classic geared scooters with combustion engines run against each other. The vehicles must be in drag race style, loud and fast. The used frames must be based on classic scooter frames, but can be reinforced, customized and extended. However, the origin of a scooter has to still be recognizable. The engines must be based on original scooter engines or can be tuning engines that have been designed especially for those vehicles. Maximum 500ccm. Engines that have an origin in a motorcycle are not allowed here.

### **::: TECHNICAL REGULATIONS & STYLE**

- Inspired by drag racing style
- Water cooled or air cooled
- Single or twin-cylinder engine, suction or supercharged (turbo, compressor)
- NOS only for engines with original cylinder stud bolt spacing (such as in original old motor housings)
- No cubic capacity limit
- No motorcycle engines
- Any fuel allowed
- Automatic gearshift allowed
- Dragster tires allowed



# ::: 101 RACE CONTROL IS GOD!

The following applies to ALL persons in the 101 starting area: The instructions of the Glemseck101 Race Control are to be obeyed in all cases. Violations will result in disqualification and/or removal from the starting area.

# ::: 101 RACE OFFICE AND ACCESS 1/8 MILE

We are expecting 140 - 150 participants. That's a large paper tiger! In advance and on site. Please help us to keep him in check. Thank you!

All confirmed participants, with a maximum of two helpers/accompanying persons, must appear in person at the 101 Race Office for final registration and to sign their waiver of liability. Without final registration and waiver of liability there is no access to the 1/8 Mile and no participation possible! Note: The 101 Race Office is always located in the center of the 101 - at the T-junction near the Hotel Glemseck!

# ::: 101 RIDERS BRIEFING

The 101 riders briefings take place on 101 Saturday and 101 Sunday morning. All participants of the 101 Sprint Day are obliged to attend! Location: Either in front of the 101 main stage or at the 101 Race Office.

# ::: MOTORCYCLE SAFETY

The technical condition is checked by the Glemseck 101-Race Control as part of a technical inspection. A motorcycle without a technical acceptance is not allowed to participate, finding no entry into the starting area.

# ::: RIDERS SAFETY - GEAR

It is required to wear stable racing and safety clothing (jacket, back protector, pants, gloves, shoes).

# ::: RIDERS SAFETY - HELMET

A full face helmet is mandatory for almost all Glemseck 101 - 1/8 Mile sprints. In the 101 Cafe Racer and 101 Classic Racer Sprint, as well as in the Moped Sprint, jet helmets (open face) are currently still allowed.

# Important: The helmet must also be presented at the technical inspection.

With a helmet without technical acceptance or which does not meet these requirements, it is not possible to start.

The helmet must meet current standards. (Status March 2024: Europa: ECE 22-05 »P«, »NP«, »J« | Japan: JIS T 8133:2007 (gültig bis 31.12.2019) JIS T 8133:2015 | USA: SNELL M 2010 (gültig bis 31.12.2019) SNELL M 2015)

### **:::** RAIN. WET TRACK

There will be no sprints on wet tracks! Should rain start to fall during a sprint, the sprint will be stopped immediately, and the 1/8 Mile will be closed.

If due to the weather conditions (wetness, rain), a sprint performance in the schedule published by Glemseck 101 is not possible, this sprint is cancelled! There is no raise of claim to a compensation sprint on the part of the participants. Race-Control decides when a sprint can be carried out and whether there is the possibility of a restart after cancellation.

# ::: »101 Breaking News« for schedule changes
