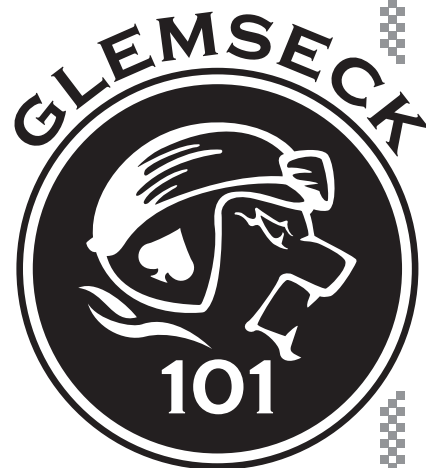


USE OF DRONES - Glemseck 101



::: For the use of drones at Glemseck 101 following applies:

According to the German Air Traffic Act, which was modified in April 2017, the use of drones is permitted for commercial purposes as long as the weight of the drone is less than 5 kg.

It's not allowed to fly over people gatherings and to people gatherings a lateral safety distance of min. 100 meters must be kept.

It is not allowed to fly over farm animals (which we have in the pasturage on the ground) and over a number of facilities that do not affect us. **The maximum flight altitude is 100 m.** The launch site of the drones, which fall under above regulation, is at the end of the 1/8 Mile sprint section. The drones can be flown over the forest and the meadows in the south.

Droning pilots working on the basis of a general German authorization* to grant permission to climb unmanned aeronautical systems, signed between 16.08.2016 and 06.04.2017, may in principle also start without permission.

For this group of persons, the above regulation of a lateral safety distance of 100 m to people gatherings does not apply!

Launch site for drone pilots who fall under this regulation is the meadow east of the "Friendship Village". **This launch site applies also to foreign countries** (not German drone pilots).

::: The following applies to all drone pilots:

1. You are not allowed to fly over people gatherings, crowds and the 1/8 Mile sprint section.
2. After your accreditation has been accomplished, you can fly daily from 10am to 7pm.
3. Mutual consideration among the drone pilots is expected.
4. It is not allowed to fly in and over the range of accidents.
5. Other aircrafts must be avoided.
6. The enacted regulations of the German Air Traffic Law and the Air Traffic Regulations must be taken into account.
7. In the case of violations of the aforementioned regulations, we reserve us the right to withdraw the accreditation.
8. For **all drone pilots**, there will be a preliminary discussion on 101 Saturday and Sunday at 11.45 am in the pre-start area of the sprint track. **For all drone pilots it is absolutely necessary to participate.**

::: In the process of accreditation the following all drone pilots have to submit:

1. General German authorization (if existing)
2. Proof of liability insurance
3. Valid Identity Card / Passport
